Board Minutes Summary

The official minutes of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board are recorded in the meeting minutes. The following is a summary of the September 13, 2022, meeting.

The meeting of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board (as held on September 13, 2022, via Zoom) was presided over by Board Chair Brian Caulfield, who also hosted the meeting from his office at the Blanchard Education Service Center, 101 / 1011on Street, Portland, Oregon. Board members present in person were Board Chair Brian Caulfield, Board member Baird Cusack, and Board Secretary Dawn Clain. Board member Brian Caulfield was also present via Zoom. The presiding officer of the meeting (as Brian Caulfield)

The meeting was called to order at 3:01 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Approval of Proposed Minutes

The minutes of the last meeting (August 30, 2022) were approved as submitted.

2. Approval of Hiring List

Statistics provided by Board Chair Brian Caulfield for this meeting indicated a total of 33 applicants, 23 (including the test), and 12 (including the interview). The average test score was 97.17, the average interview score was 71.87, and the overall average was 93.37. Ten candidates were on the hiring list.

Board Chair Brian Caulfield confirmed that the Board's rules and regulations were followed, and the list was approved.

Board Chair Brian Caulfield advised the Board that all ten applicants started work, PPS could have 319 full-time employees of the 337 allotted; and definitively headed towards the goal of filling all the positions.
