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The purpose of this memo is to outline both the physical and functional capacity calculations as we apply these metrics to schools, in this case specifically our new Kellogg Middle School. It is of critical importance to note the difference as it relates to the viability of providing appropriate educational and support services for students.

This basis for the following capacity calculation is the size and number of classrooms<sup>1</sup>. Classrooms are 500 square feet.

Functional Capacity is the District's primary indicator of the number of students supported by a given building. The average functional capacity for middle schools across the District is 733 student stations and at Kellogg Middle School it is 765.
