A bibliography is a list of materials and sources you have used in researching a topic for a report. Follow the examples below for the way to identify your sources of information. An example follows each description.

Book with One Author

Author's Name. <u>Title of Book</u>. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Adams, Simon. <u>Life in Ancient Rome</u>. Boston: Kingfisher, 2005.

Book with Two Authors

Author's Name and second Author's Name. <u>Title of Book</u>. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Jakobson, Roman, and Linda R. Waugh. <u>The Sound Shape of Language</u>. Bloomington: Indiana University Press, 1979.

Book Article or Chapter with Author

Author's Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Book</u>. Editor of Book. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright Date. Pages.

James, Nancy E. "Two Sides of Paradise." <u>Spectrum of the Fantastic</u>. Ed. Donald Palumbo. Westport, CT: Greenwood, 1988. 219-223.

Encyclopedia or Reference Book with an Author

Author's Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Book</u>, Copyright Date. Akmund, Joseph. "Wizards." <u>The World Book Encyclopedia</u>. 1993.
