What are safety data sheets? – *continued*

Where do employers get safety data sheets?

Chemical manufacturers, importers, and distributors must provide safety data sheets assessing the hazards of chemicals with the SDS. SDSs may also be obtained from retailers that sell the chemical.



What information is required on safety data sheets?

Safety data sheets must contain the following information:

- 1. Manufacturer or distributor name, address, telephone number, and email address.
- 2. Product name and identification number.
- 3. Hazard classification and pictograms.
- 4. Hazard statements and precautionary statements.
- 5. Physical and chemical properties.
- 6. Toxicological information.
- 7. Environmental information.
- 8. Transport information.
- 9. Regulatory information.
- 10. Other relevant information.
